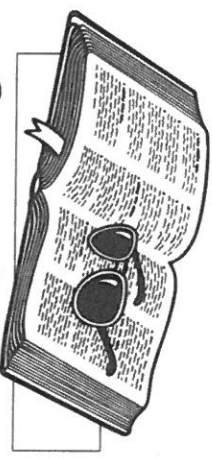


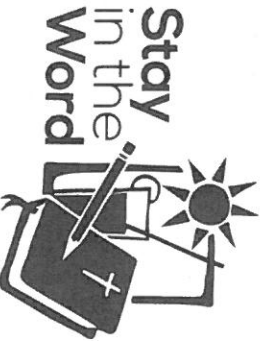

Pastors' Column

June 2019

Dear Friends in Christ,

Our summers are filled with opportunities and expectations. Vacation plans, family visits, sports, summer jobs for the young people, and a variety of other activities too numerous to list. We find ourselves having to make decisions.

One of those decisions is how we are going to practice our Christian faith. Some of those decisions require some effort. If we are committed to worship each week, that means we have to find a way to make time and if travelling find a place to worship. If we are committed to living the Christian faith of caring for others and making financial donations to the work of the church, that will require some thought and commitment.

Sometimes, the decisions we make about living the Christian life mean life and death.

Dietrich Bonhoeffer was a Lutheran Pastor during WWII. He is one of many examples of people who chose to live their faith, even if that choice meant death. Bonhoeffer was doing post graduate studies and teaching at Union Seminary in the 1930's. He felt he returned to Germany to teach future pastors there. He was eventually arrested and imprisoned. The last time he was seen alive, he was kneeling before the gallows, naked and praying the Lord's Prayer. He was executed two weeks before the war was over. His faith decisions cost him his life.

For some good TV viewing this summer, watch for "**Bonhoeffer: Agent of Grace**," which will debut on PBS on **Wednesday, June 14, at 9:30 p.m. ET (or check your local listings)**. The PR promises "a vital portrait of the man, the teacher, the resistance fighter, the moralist, the prisoner and, eventually, the martyr"—but the film delivers even more. It shows us a theologian in action, rethinking what it means to serve God, love others, and, especially, to tell the truth.

If you wish to learn more about Pastor Bonhoeffer, a variety of books can be found on Amazon. Two classics I recommend, "Life Together" and "The Cost of Discipleship." Pastor Bonhoeffer lived his faith and he died living his faith.
